PHYSICIAN SHADOWING PROGRAM

The Physician Shadowing program brochure can be downloaded from www.nmhs.net/youth_programs.php. The program is designed for pre-med students who have completed their sophomore year of college. Applicants must be available to work the entire three weeks if accepted.

Two sessions are offered each summer with six students each. The first session is scheduled for June 13-July 1, 2016, and the second session is July 11-29, 2016. Applicants may request which session they prefer; however, there is no guarantee. Selected individuals are hired, provided a lab coat and paid minimum wage while in the program.

Interested students may apply at www.nmhs.net/employment_opportunities.php after March 7, 2016. When completing the application, select NMHS (North Mississippi Health Services) as the facility. Then select "Physician Shadower" as the position you are applying for. Application deadline is April 20.

To apply the following items must be submitted:

- Completed employment application (see above)
- Written statement expressing why you aspire to be a doctor, as well as how shadowing a physician would be beneficial to you. Also list previous experience you have in health care such as volunteer work, job shadowing, internship, employment, etc.
- Two letters of recommendation (mail to the address below or email to rcampbel@nmhs.net)
- **Official** college transcript (send by Safe Script or mail to the address below)
