- Complete application

- High school transcript
- ACT score if taken - not required

Interviews will be at NMMC in Tupelo from 2:30-4:30 p.m. on Dec. 1-5.

Following successful completion of the Mentorship Academy, each participant will receive certified nursing assistant training during the summer. This training will prepare participants for the certification exam and employment opportunities that can lead to an exciting career in health care.
